





MUSICAL MINISTRY

The year 2025 has begun. The new Semester of The Music Department of The Mission has begun. Just like last year we have 24 teachers. At four Schools in Sacramento and Yolo Counties, children receive free music lessons. In total, there are about 600 children in schools. Pray for our teachers and their students.

Serving the Music Department of the Mission in Schools is a blessing for the children of our city and we are glad to have the opportunity to share our musical talents with them.

Unfortunately, not all parents have the opportunity to purchase musical instruments for their children. Most of our students are children from low-income families. We pro-

vide rent-free tools to such families, but there is still a need to purchase new tools to meet all the needs of the children. First of all, it is the purchase of a violin, guitar, keyboards, recorder and bongos.

To help poor families to purchase an instrument, you can do it through our Mission.

You will receive a tax-exempt receipt for donations. We will gratefully accept any Gift of Love from you to underprivileged children and hope that with your help, we will increase the number of free Musical Instrument rentals for the children of our city.











REACHING UNREACHED NATIONS

There are still many unreached peoples on earth. One of these peoples is the Uzbek Gypsies-Mugata. They are popularly called Luli. They practice Islam and lead a lifestyle similar to Gypsies from European countries. Most of them live very poorly. Uzbeks have a rather negative attitude towards Luli, as well as towards other Gypsies. But our brothers in Uzbekistan are bringing the message of Salvation to these people as well.

The head of our Street Ministry, Brother Vasily, spent three weeks in Uzbekistan with local brothers helping them to spread the Gospel among

this people. They held services for Luli in Yangy Bazaar and Bukhara. We held a three-day camp for Gypsies children. There were about 50 children and several adult Gypsies. In the evening, they took to the streets of Bukhara and testified to people about Christ with the help of paintings by famous artists based on Biblical subjects.

Another category of Unreached Peoples is the deafmute Uzbeks. The attitude towards deaf-mutes in Uzbekistan is the same as towards Gypsies. Or worse. Hearing them pronounce sounds incoherently, many people consider them to be possessed and

avoid them. Perhaps for this reason, the deaf and dumb, through the love and attention shown to them, willingly accept the Gospel message about the Lord.

Vasily and his brothers visited two cities, Nurabad and Jizzakh. These cities already have registered Churches and their own Houses of Worship. There are already at least 50 Church members in each city, mostly deaf-mutes and many children. Interestingly, children of the deaf and dumb speak normally.

There were blessed services and repentance of a deaf-mute man. During the service, he stood up and began to show something with his gestures. The translation sister said: he wants to turn to the Lord. He approached the pulpit and also began to pray to God with gestures and ask for forgiveness for his sins. What do you think? Does the Lord hear such prayers?

We urge you to pray for these distant peoples as well. Christ suffered for them on Golgotha, too. If the Lord disposes your heart to help the brothers in Uzbekistan in their work among these nationalities, you can do this through our Mission.





PAKISTAN

ur brothers in Pakistan have a special ministry. The number of Christians in Pakistan is about 2.5 million people. In addition to the Muslim community, Hindus live in Pakistan. There are also converts from Muslims, but more are converted to Christ from Hinduism.

A special group where our brothers preach the Gospel is the brick-making workers. Pakistan is the world's largest brick producer, but the price of this achievement is very high: millions of forced laborers, including children, are employed in brick production from early morning until late evening. It's mostly manual labor.

More than 20% of Pakistan's population is below the poverty line. To make ends meet, many have to take loans from factory owners at exorbitant interest rates. Borrowers, as a rule, are unable to repay the money, and are forced to work to pay off the debt, while receiving meager payments that will never repay the ever-growing loan amount. Millions of people in the country are still involved in bonded labor.

In case of death of a worker, his family members are forced to work off the debt. This is how more and more new generations fall into slavery. Such families are actually kept as prisoners; they cannot leave the workplace until the debt is paid. Minors are in the most vulnerable situation: approximately 3.6 million children under the age of 14 are involved in bonded labor. Children injure their fingers and eyes in the workplace, and many go blind.

Our brothers and sisters preach in these places and many accept Christ. Churches in Pakistan are actively involved in fundraising and ransoming Christian families from slavery. Some families have debts in the range of 1,000 – 1,500 dollars, but they are unable to pay them off.

Most Americans can easily buy a Christian family out of slavery. Maybe someone will respond to this God-pleasing cause. Not going on a Cruise Ship or to a Resort once can give freedom to one family in Pakistan.

If the Christians of America had decided, one time, instead of Christmas Gifts, to dedicate these funds to the liberation of people, there would no longer be brick slaves in Pakistan. Most importantly, – It would be the most valuable gift to Jesus.

Another need. The brothers organized a School for children whose parents are in brick slavery. There are 103 children and 7 teachers in the School. Rent, student needs, teacher salary – \$850 per month. For children, this is a chance to escape from slavery. It is very difficult there to find a job without education. Unfortunately, the organization that sponsored this School is no longer able to provide assistance. The Church in Okara asked us to take care of this School. All the children come from Christian families. May the Lord encourage you to give hope to these children. Information is available by
